Late sign-in begins at 9:00 A. M.

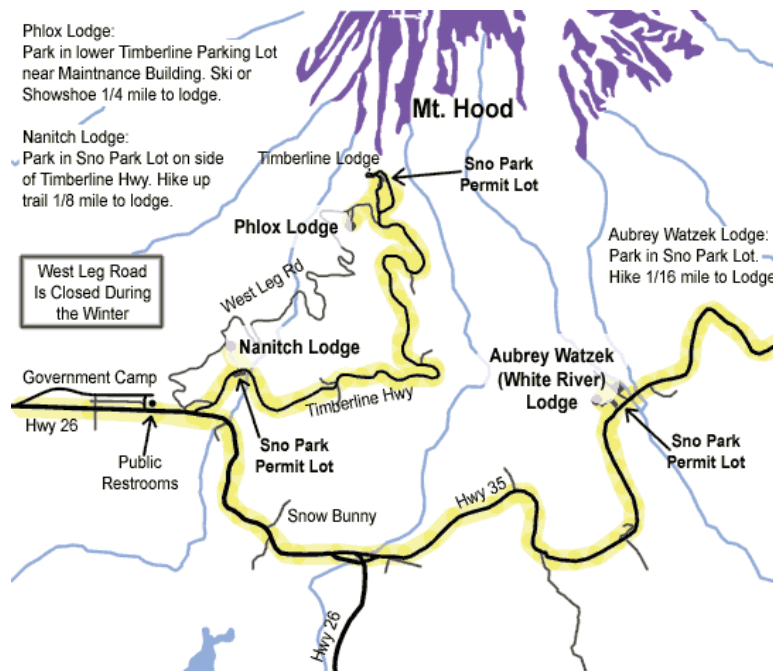
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Draw for all Cub Scout dates will be held at Aubrey Watzek Lodge

⇒ **CLEAN UP DAY DETAILS:**

- ⇒ The lodge clean-up day provides an opportunity to spruce up Aubrey Watzek Lodge and Nanitch Lodge for an exciting winter of non-stop action. ***Only those packs that participate in the clean-up day can sign up for a day of winter lodge fun in the snow.***
- ⇒ Most cleaning items will be provided; however, you can help by bringing brooms, dust pans, mops, vacuums, buckets, rubber gloves, and any other cleaning items you might have.
- ⇒ For the craftsman, carpenter, plumber, or electrician, please bring your special tools and we will have you work on one of the many building maintenance projects on the list.
- ⇒ All units signing in prior to 9:00 A. M. will be in the first draw. Units signing in after 9:00 A. M. will be in the second draw.
- ⇒ The draw will be held after both lodges have been cleaned (usually around 1pm)
- ⇒ ***Bring a sack lunch with drink for the ride home.*** There is no lunch break - we will work through to the draw.

⇒ **FEES:**

- ⇒ ***Cub Scout day use fee is \$ 8.00 (FOS \$7.00) per person per day. Each reservation will require a \$4.00 deposit per person per day payable at the clean-up.*** The number of spaces you reserve should be as close as possible to the number of youth and adults planning to attend. The deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. ***Make checks payable to BSA. The remaining \$4.00 (FOS \$3.00) per person per day is due 30 days prior to the event date.***
  - ⇒ **All fees must be paid in advance of your use and within 30 days of your event date.**
  - ⇒ A **\$20 late fee** will be assessed when payment is not made within **30 days** of your event date.
  - ⇒ If payment is not received within **21 days** of your event date, **your reservation will be cancelled** and your space offered to other units. No refund will be made.
  - ⇒ **No refunds will be made.** The **ONLY** exception is when ODOT closes the highway. Winter weather conditions are not reason for refund.
- ⇒ Your reservation form will be filled out at the lodge on clean up day. **You will need the policy number of your pack's unit accident insurance.** Use the list of tentative dates below to plan your choices prior to the clean-up. Suggestion: bring a list of dates in order of preference so you can select dates quickly.
- ⇒ If the lodge is not full, additional spaces can be purchased at the Portland volunteer service desk after October 22.
- ⇒ A winter lodge director will be assigned to each snow day and will try to contact you prior to your visit to answer any questions.
- ⇒ ***ABSOLUTELY NO siblings or non registered youth (except potential new Cub Scouts of appropriate age and gender) will be permitted to attend the snow day activity. There are NO EXCEPTIONS made to this policy.***
- ⇒ Inner tubes are provided. No skiing, sledding, tobogganing, snowmobiling, or ATV use is allowed.

**There is a maximum of 250 spaces at Aubrey Watzek and 120 spaces at Nanitch.**
